We are currently developing our Local Plan, which will underpin the work required to ensure Stockport continues to be a great place to live, work and do business.

The Local Plan will cover a wide range of development needs for the borough which local people have told us are really important, including new homes, transport and infrastructure – ensuring local places facilitate thriving communities and the economy. It will also reinforce our commitment to protecting the environment and working together to address climate change.

As part of this work, we are looking to identify Brownfield Sites in Stockport that may be suitable for development. Even if you don't own the land, we would be keen to hear about land you may be aware of, so we can plan to meet Stockport's growing needs. These sites will be considered before we need to make decisions in respect of other land.

All sites put forward will be assessed against a range of criteria to make sure that they deliver the aims and objectives of the Local Plan. Following this assessment, we will publish the Local Plan document for consultation, which is likely to be in Autumn 2021.
